English Naturally Code of Conduct Summer Schools 2019

We want you to have fun during your stay at the English Naturally Summer School but it is important for your safety and enjoyment of the course that you adhere to the following rules.

Students are expected to:

- Be in **full attendance** each day to lessons, work experience and activities unless unwell.
- Be **on time** for lessons in the morning and work experience/activities/trips in the afternoons.
- Have fun but behave in a civilised way in classes, activities and work experience
- Treat other students, teachers, activity leaders and host families with **respect**.
- Adhere to the **curfew times** when not on an organised evening activity. The curfew times are as follows:

Age band	Latest time home
11-12	Not allowed out
13-14	2030
15+	2200

 Talk to your host family (and make sure they are in agreement) if you are planning to stay out with friends after classes and what time you are planning to be back as well as whether you will be returning for an evening meal with them. If you are intending to eat dinner out, please also let your host family know. Students should be aware that in England, families quite often eat their evening meal much earlier than they may be used to at home.

There is a strict **no smoking** rule whilst in classrooms, during work experience and at home with your host family (unless this has been agreed). There may be specific rules about smoking in each summer school which your Centre Manager will let you know about on your first day.

Alcoholic drinks are **not allowed** to be consumed at any time by **any** student at the EN summer school

No non-medical drugs are allowed. If we find students breaking this rule, we will contact your agents/parents to notify them and a decision will be made to decide if you can continue your stay. Any early return will be at the student's own cost.

Mobile phones may **not** be used during lesson time, work experience or activities unless instructed by the teacher or activity leader.

Students should be aware that the following is against the law in the UK

- Smoking in any public building
- Non-prescribed drugs, including cannabis and psychoactive substances (formerly known as 'legal highs')
- Carrying an offensive weapon (including small pocket knives)
- Causing a disturbance
- Shoplifting or theft of any kind

For students under 18 years, it is illegal to

- Buy alcohol
- To buy alcohol for anyone under the age of 18
- Buy tobacco
- Buy tobacco for other under the age of 18

For students under 16 years, it is illegal to

Smoke tobacco
